Financial Changes for Scouting Year 09/01/10-08/31/11

❖ Scouting Year 2010 Pack Fee

- Fee will be \$156
 - Scouting Year 2009 fees were \$180 (\$40 Registration & \$140 Fundraising commitment)
- These fees will cover:
 - Boy Scout's of America registration and insurance fees of \$16.25
 - 12 month subscription to Boy's Life magazine of \$12.00
 - One year of the Pack 372 Ideal Year of Scouting Activities:
 - At least bi-weekly den meetings and den supplies (Sept. 2010 – May 2011)
 - Monthly pack shows and pack show supplies (Sept. 2010 – May 2011)
 - Scout advancement items (rank badges and awards, belt loops, pack sponsored activity patches, pack sponsored activity awards)
 - One raingutter regatta boat kit, one pinewood derby car kit, and one rocket day rocket kit
 - Scout admission to Blue & Gold banquet
- Pack fee is payable in three installments of \$52 each
 - September 1, 2010, December 1, 2010, February 1, 2010

❖ Individual Scout Accounts

- A Scout Account is a way for Scouts to earn their own way through scouting. The money is owned by Pack 372, but it is set aside for use by a particular scout.
- Before the start of each fundraising activity the Pack Committee will decide how sales from that activity will be applied to the Pack general fund and the individual scout accounts
 - **Example:** 2010 Take Order Popcorn – the first \$520 in gross sales (the Pack retains \$156 of this (30%)– the remainder is given to the Council for their share and to pay for the popcorn) will be applied to the Pack general fund to cover the Scout's \$156 Pack fee. For every dollar sold over \$520 – 15% will go to the Individual Scout's Account, 15% will go to the Pack 372 general fund, and 70% is sent to Council. (This example assumes a 30% commission on popcorn sales.)
- The Individual Scout Account money can be used for:
 - Pack, District, or Council sponsored camps (including day camp, and resident camp)
 - Uniform and handbook purchases
 - Camping supplies – to include one tent and one sleeping bag
